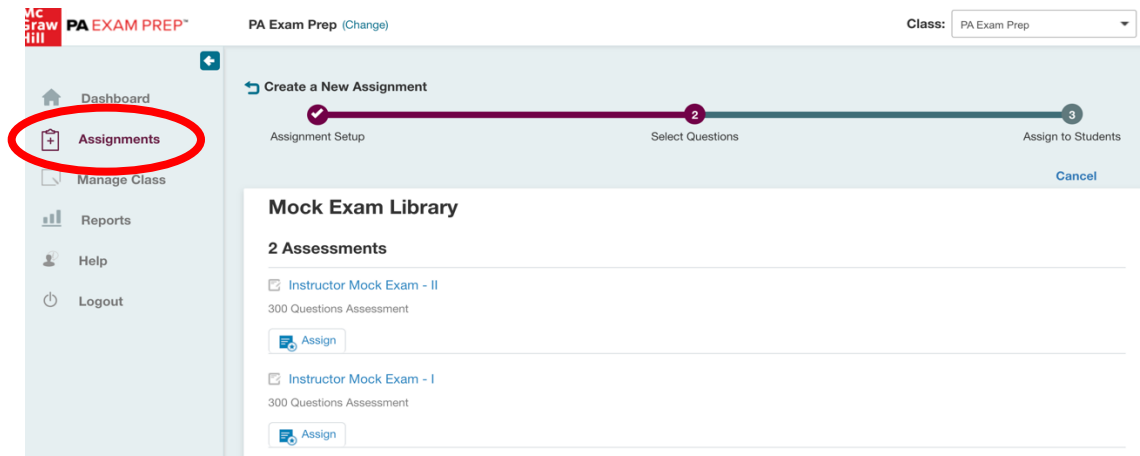


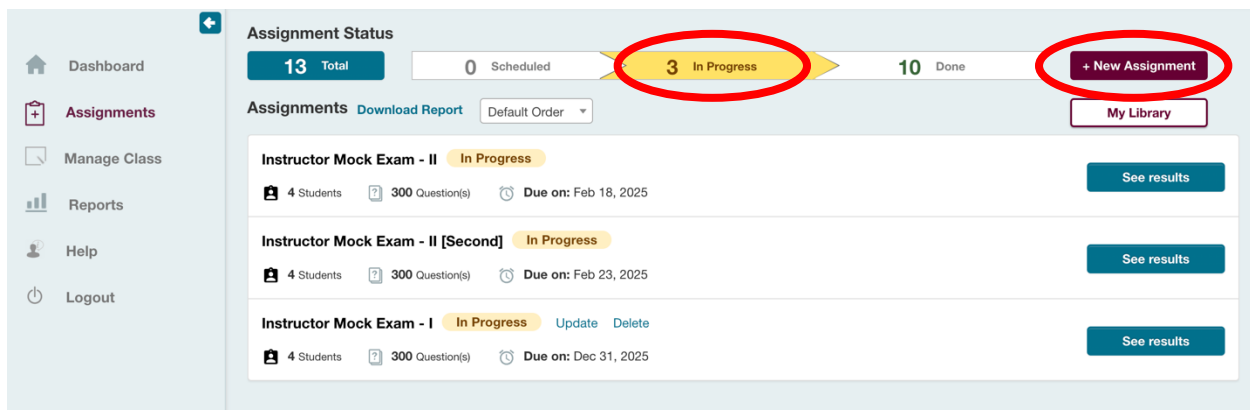
## PA Exam Prep: Student vs. Instructor Mock Exams

**Purpose:** Demonstrate the difference between Student and Instructor Mock exams and show what each user will view in their dashboard.

### Instructor Account



(Above) In the Instructor Account, Instructors have access to **The Mock Exam Library** with 2 unique exams titled “Instructor Mock Exam – I” and “Instructor Mock Exam – II.” Each exam is 300 questions and instructors can enable or disable the time limit.



**To access the Mock Exams**, select “Assignments” in the left navigation bar, then “+New Assignment” > “Select an Exam from the Mock Library.”

In the image above, you see the instructor’s account “**Assignment Status**” page, filtered for “**In Progress.**” Notice that **both** Mock Exams are assigned and In Progress, meaning within the open dates window for students to complete. Instructors may assign a Mock Exam more than once to a section (as seen with “Instructor Mock Exam – II”).

In the Student Account, students have access to their own unique Mock Exam under **“Mock Exam”** in the left navigation bar. Students may begin, then **“Save and Exit”** the exam to continue at another time. This will show **“In Progress”** as the status.

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Students can see their assigned Mock Exams (assigned from the instructor) under **“Assignments”**. You can see the 3 Mock Exams as **“Not Started”** status (assigned from instructor in above example). Once started, they will move to **“In Progress.”** (below)
